

Expressing likes, dislikes, and preferences

German

- Verb + *gern*
- Ich gehe *gern* ins Kino.
- Ich koche *gern*.

- Verb + *nicht gern*
- Ich gehe *nicht gern* ins Kino.

- Ich koche *nicht gern*.

- Verb + *lieber*
- Ich gehe *lieber* ins Restaurant.

English

- I like to go to the movies.
- I like to cook.

- I don't like to go to the movies.

- I don't like to cook.

- I prefer to go to a restaurant.

NOTE: *gern* is not used as a verb but rather as an adverb. Therefore one could not say: (*ich **gern** ins Kino*) as this would imply I like to the movies.
